An Interactive Therapeutic Tabletop Role Play Game Group**

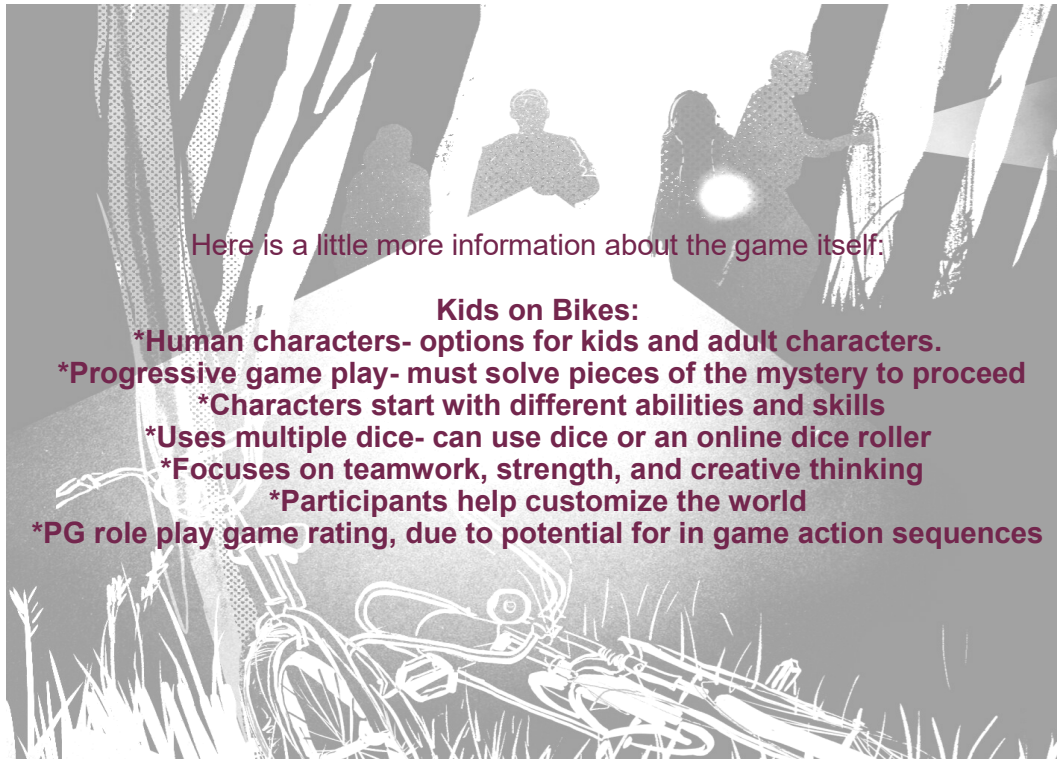
Adventurous Teens Needed!

- *Human characters- options for kids and adult characters.
- *Progressive game play- must solve pieces of the mystery to proceed
- *Characters start with different abilities and skills
- *Uses multiple dice- can use dice or an online dice roller
- *Focuses on teamwork, strength, and creative thinking
- *Participants help customize the world
- *PG role play game rating, due to potential for in game action sequences
